JOURNEY

The patient wanted to have a fresher look without changing her eye shape and appearance.

TREATMENT

The patient underwent an Upper Blepharoplasty. This procedure involves identifying the upper eyelid

crease on each eyelid and designing a skin excision that removes enough skin to alleviate the issue and preserves enough to allow normal eyelid closure. In some cases, a small amount of the orbicularis oculi (the muscle that closes the eyelid) is removed. Fat is typically preserved over the middle of the eyelid, but some removal may help with aesthetic contour in cosmetic eyelid surgery.

When the procedure is complete, the eyelid is closed with sutures. The incision lies in the eyelid crease, making it less visible after healing.

RECOVERY & FOLLOW-UP

The patient was able to resume light activities after one week from the procedure. She experienced some swelling for brief period but she was recovered faster than expected.

RESULTS

The pictures above are post 9 months of the surgery. The patient loved the results.
